# *Course Preservation Report*

## **Draft Plans of Management**

Note: all National Parks & Wildlife Service Plans of Management, both draft and finalised, can be viewed at the NPWS website at <http://www.environment.nsw.gov.au/parkmanagement/ParkAndFireManagementPlansByCategory.htm>

You can make submissions by post, email or directly from the website. A submission is simply your comments on the plan of management, whether agreeing or disagreeing with what is being proposed.

Willandra National Park— north-west of Griffith. Horse riding not permitted in future although previously permitted in the past. Submissions close 31 December 2010.

Cumbebin Swamp Nature Reserve – Byron Bay. Horse riding not mentioned therefore not permitted. Submissions close 7 February 2011.

Back River and Tomalla Nature Reserves – near Nundle. Horse riding not mentioned therefore not permitted, however Tomalla Forest Way is a public access road crossing the reserve, and it is unclear whether this road remains open to horse riders. Submissions close 21 February 2011.

Joadja and Wollondilly River Nature Reserves – west of Mittagong, on the southern side of Wombeyan Caves Rd. Horse riding not permitted. Submissions close 21 March 2011.

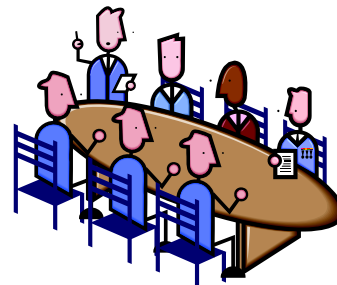

### Your weight is your responsibility

The NSW State Management Committee would like to remind riders that it is the riders responsibility to maintain the minimum weight if you chose to ride middleweight or heavyweight at rides. Please remember that you must weigh in pre-ride with the gear you will be riding in (excluding your bridle) and nothing else. Some people may lose weight during a ride, so please ensure you have a couple of kilos up your sleeve so you do not risk disqualification at the end of the ride.

## **TIE UP YOUR DOGS—or else !!!!!**

The AERA has received complaints of unrestrained dogs are roaming the campsite stealing food, urinating on camping equipment, hay and feed and generally creating a nuisance. They also represent a very real danger to the safety of horses and riders.

**Riders are responsible for the behaviour of their support crews and friends.**

**This extends to dogs associated with their camp**, which must be restrained at all times, either on a lead or secured in a float or vehicle.

The Chief Steward may disqualify a rider from the ride if that riders' support crew or friends cause disruption detrimental to the running of the ride. Refusal to restrain a dog (of any size) after being requested to do so by the Chief Steward, or an official of the Organising Ride Committee, may also lead to disqualification of the rider. Unless the control of dogs at rides improves significantly, the SMC will be forced to review this situation further.

**So if you want to continue taking your dog(s) to rides, do the right thing by ensuring they are restrained at all times.**

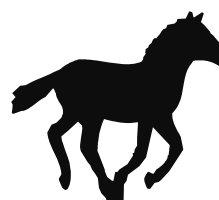

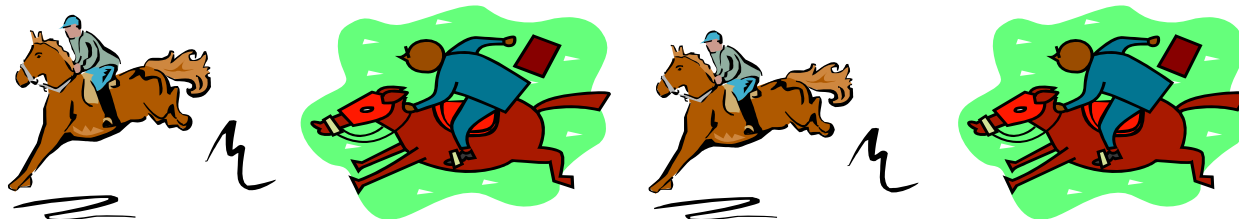

## RIDE PREVIEW - 15 May 2011

If coming through the Mudgee township, drive north along Ulan Road for 10kms, then turn right into Wollar Road. The grounds are 13kms along Wollar Road. You cant' miss it.

You'll be driving south, past the mines, through Cooks Gap (don't blink or you'll miss it) then turn left into Linburn Lane (approx 56kms from the Golden Highway). # 2011 Zone One Championship Ride

## 100km Elevator Ride – 80km Completion

### 40km Training Ride – 20km Social Ride

The 2011 Zone One Championships 100km elevator endurance ride will be held at the Upper Colo Reserve, Colo on Sunday 8th May. There will be signs from the Colo Bridge on Putty Road turning you onto Upper Colo Road for a few kms and an arrow turning vehicles right down and over the bridge into the Reserve.

The three legs are made up of the following distances – 45km, 35kms & 20kms with plenty of water available out on track and exceptional marking to ensure nobody gets lost!! We are unable to use arrows in the National Park so please look for signs and tape with comfort tape to assure you that you have turned in the right direction.

The 45km 1st leg will leave base on the new access road, over the Upper Colo bridge, left onto Upper Colo Road proceeding to a turnaround point on Lower Colo Road approximately 18 kms from base. Then back to the checkpoint at Atkinson's gate where you will be turned in and up Wheeney Creek Valley to another checkpoint at the power lines at Comleroy Road, turning right and down to Upper Colo Road where you turn right and then left to the base via the bridge and access road.

The 35km 2nd leg will be out of the ride base turning right into Upper Colo Road and left in the access road to the Fire Station and heading up Ward's track and on through the National Park and Gaspers Track coming out into Sams Way where you will turn right and come round left to the water stop on Mountain Lagoon Road and then proceeding down MLR to Comleroy Road and turn left and go down past the church and turning right along Upper Colo Road left over the bridge as before.

The 20km 3rd leg will be out of the base on the access route, over the bridge turning right into Upper Colo Road to a turnaround point and back into base as before.

The 40km Training Ride is ideal for fit young and/or novice horses and will be the same track as the 2nd leg of the 100kms with a variation to add 5kms to the track on Sams Way which will be marked clearly. The 20km Social ride will be the 3rd leg of the 100km ride, being flat and easy going - perfect for anyone wanting to try their hand at Endurance Riding for the first time.

The ride base is located on the beautiful Colo River - with a grassy camping area and access to the sandy beach. Dogs are allowed, but please remember to keep them on a leash at all times. A \$6 Camping Fee is payable to the National Parks ranger.

Vetting will be between 2 and 5pm Saturday and from 7am for the trainer and social riders on the Sunday. Pre-ride talk will be 6.30 pm around the office and canteen area.

The 100km Elevator ride will start at 4am Sunday, the 40km Trainer will start at 9am and the Social will start at 10am.

1 **QERA Motion 1 Rule A5.1 wording**

**That**

**These times must be expressed as a cut off time on the clock and must not be less than a time based on an average speed of 10 kilometres an hour is added to the rule**

**Rationale:** Much discussion has been held since it was reported that a Chief Steward in Victoria interpreted this rule by setting a maximum time for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> legs and disqualified riders for riding the course under 8 hours. QERA believes the rules needs very little change and express the maximum time as the cut off time and must be expressed as the time on the clock. A rider cannot be disqualified for riding under 8 hours.

#### Withdrawn

#### 2 VERA Motion 1 Rule A5 wording

- A5.1** "Maximum riding times for all marathon, endurance, training and introductory rides will be set by the Chief Steward in consultation with the Head Vet and the Ride Committee."
- A5.2** "The maximum time will apply to the whole ride and must not be less than a time calculated for an average speed not greater than 10 kph."
- A5.3** "Notwithstanding rule 5.2, a 'cut-off' time may be applied, after which, riders will not be allowed to commence the last leg of the days riding. This 'cut-off' time will be calculated so as to allow the rider to ride the last leg at a pace of not more than 10 kph."

**Rationale:** The above wording allows marathon rides to set ride times on a per day basis. It effectively means that a course would 'open' for a set time and riders must complete the course within that time. This 'course open' idea would apply to all types of rides including elevator rides. The last leg 'cut-off' would allow riders entering elevator rides to complete the minimum distance at an average speed of less than 10 kph and still receive the credit for the distance covered. They may successfully complete the first two legs but would not be allowed to commence the last leg as they would not complete it within the required total time. It does not confine riders to maintain a minimum speed of 10 kph, under certain circumstances they will be able to travel much slower, and if they travel quickly on the first leg or legs they can slow down without penalty as they are riding to a total ride average time. Maximum times for training and introductory rides can also be calculated using slower speeds than 10kph. This may be useful where there are unfit riders and/or horses and the vet ring is still open to service a longer ride. It seems unfair to disqualify a newcomer to the sport because they have travelled slower than an arbitrarily pace set by a ride committee when there is still plenty of daylight left and the vet ring won't be packed up for some time.

Tom wants an amendment to 5.3 so that there is a cut off time for the last leg. He explained the scenarios

- A5.1** "Maximum riding times for all marathon, endurance, training and introductory rides will be set by the Chief Steward in consultation with the Head Vet and the Ride Committee."

- A5.3** "Notwithstanding rule 5.2, a 'cut-off' time may be applied **where a ride consists of 3 legs or more**, after which, riders will not be allowed to commence the last leg of the days riding. This 'cut-off' time will be calculated so as to allow the rider to ride the last leg at a pace of not more than 10 kph."

**24.6 A horse who is successfully vetted through at the completion of a ride may subsequently receive intravenous fluids without compromising its qualification in the ride.**

**Justification:** To allow horses to receive IV fluids earlier and limit the danger to their health and welfare that is posed by riders holding horses back from treatment until the 2 hours post ride. Note that as per H15.8 such a horse would not be eligible for consideration for the best conditioned award.

This rule replaces the 2 hour rule. Anne is to ask Brian Sheahan for a full rationale to present at the AGM's. We can see both sides of the argument – the horse welfare issue and the potential to override. It could go in as a separate rule but leave the 2 hour rule. Imbil was a good example. Pat is to discuss on the vet chatline.

#### 4 QERA Motion 2 Trainers

**That the following is added to the RIDER RULES**

**R14 Trainers**

**A person who presents a horse for entry into an affiliated ride, when that person is not the rider of the horse in that ride.**

**A trainer may or may not be the owner of the horse that is being entered in the ride.**

**A trainer must be a current member of a division, and must present their membership card when nominating a horse for a ride.**

**A trainer has the same rights and responsibilities as any other member, and is subject to the rules contained in the Members Handbook.**

**A trainer who has their membership suspended for whatever reason must pay a fee to transfer any horse(s) in their ownership. The amount of this fee is to be determined by the relevant Division SMC from time to time.**

**Rationale:** For some time there has been concern about Trainers who are not members or are suspended. This rule defines trainers and gives the Association some power to deal with issues that arise with them.

Steve explained there are a lot of people participating in rides but do not ride – Business people, trainers, mentors etc. Rules need to be broadened to bring them in line with the rule book. They use the same membership/administration facilities that members do for free. The owner issue is more important. He pulled the rules out of the FEI and Australian Racing Board. The important rule is 14.6 that loses the right for horses to compete. Tom McCormack stated that the entry form could be re-designed to include, rider, owner, trainer etc. Trainers need to be defined. Pat commented pm 14.2, 14.6 asking what if a horse is owned by more than one person.

Ross complimented Steve on the thought that he has put in to address the situation. He feels that it is going in the right direction. Tom asked whether they should be an associate or full member. It would be preferable to be a full member – the sport is shrinking and they have use of the membership services. Tom feels that we should start with the owner as that is more easily defined. How to maintain currency of an owner could be a problem. This could be overcome by having an owner label that has to be updated yearly like the registration. The database could do a check on owner currency.

It was agreed that QERA would take it back and look at it for the next meeting.

#### **4 Owners of AERA Registered Horses**

**That the following is added into ADMINISTRATION OF RIDE RULES**

##### **A14 Owners of AERA Registered Horses**

**An owner is the member who has verified their ownership of a horse with the Division Registrar, and whose name is recorded on the Owner/Agent label on the inside back cover of that horse's logbook.**

**A horse may be owned by more than one person.**

**If a horse has multiple owners, or is owned by a company, the name of the person whose address is given as the ownership contact when registering the horse shall be shown on the Owner/Agent label.**

**Division Registrars accept registrations on the understanding that the person or body making the application is the bona fide owner, part-owner or lessee of the horse.**

**Neither the AERA or any of its divisions will accept any responsibility on cases of disputed ownership.**

**Owners of horses must be current members of a Division.**

**Rationale:** This Rule clarifies the ownership of a horse  
Refer above.

#### **5 QERA Motion 3**

**That new rule A11.7 is added into Administration of Ride Rules**

**A11.7 A Ride Committee shall accept ride entries from any member of any division, unless a relevant SMC has previously given that Ride Committee authority to refuse ride entry to a particular member.**

**Rationale:** It has been most significant and important that when this has arisen both Charleville and Oz Endurance clubs have consulted with us first, before refusing entry to members, and it is essential that this protocol continue.

Motion withdrawn.

**SA Quilty 2011:** Sarah advised that she has resigned from the Quilty Committee and Melanie is representing them. Discussion was held on the test event and changes that will be made for the Quilty.

**Tasmania 2012:**

**Moved** Pat Hodgetts/Neil Clarkson

**That** Tom McCormack is appointed as the Chief Steward for the 2012 Tom Quilty.

**Voting** Carried Unanimously

**Moved** Dorte Colja/Melanie Scott



**That** **Pat Hodgetts is appointed as the Head Vet for the 2012 Tom Quilty with Anne Barnes as a replacement if necessary.**

**Voting** Carried Unanimously

Pat showed the logo. The colours will be orange and blue. They are hoping to have official arrows and the colour marking system in place. The Committee will be responsible for the ride numbers.

Pat and Tom will work on the manual regarding the track and treatment vet.

Kevin Brewster will be doing the Quilty website. It was suggested that a website [www.Quilty.com](http://www.Quilty.com) be created with links to the current Quilties. Anne will speak to Elaine about it.

**Queensland 2013:** QERA have accepted a proposal to hold the Quilty at Kilkivan in 2013. An information pack was provided and a full proposal will be submitted in March.

#### **Course Marking Standard**

**Moved** Tom McCormack/Katrina Westerhoff

**That** **the Tom Quilty Course Marking Standard document is adopted into the Quilty Manual.**

**Voting** Carried Unanimously

The Quilty manual is a work in progress.

#### **Minimum ride Standards**

Tom presented a document on Ride Standards. He agreed that each State does things a little different but that should not be an impediment. He is proposing that the States go to the AGM's and come back in March next year with a wish list.

He proposes that each State would be given \$3,000 per year to improve their Ride Standards. Flexibility is needed for States that have already invested in equipment such as arrows etc. Tom will discuss the requirements with each State starting with arrows. The arrows should be printed with AERA on them.

Tom also wants to propose that AERA pays for a Chief Steward from each State to come to the Quilty. The Quilty Committee would pay for accommodation, transfers, one dinner ticket and meals during the event. Meals outside the event hours and incidental travel costs, airport parking etc would be the responsibility of the Chief Steward. The Chief Steward would need to be at the event by 4:00 p.m. Thursday.

He would then like to write to the States and invite them to submit the name of another Chief Steward to participate under the same terms and conditions but they pay. The AERA Chief Stewards would be Dorte Colja, Jeff Bonham, Debbie Symington, Sarah Adams, Helen Bowkett and Sandy Little. They are all Quilty experienced Chief Stewards and would provide consistency and autonomy.

**Moved** Tom McCormack/Pat Hodgetts

**That the AERA pays the travel expenses for the Tom Quilty core Chief Steward team to go to the Tom Quilty, travel expenses defined as a single return airfare to/from the most appropriate airport. The Tom Quilty Committee is to be responsible to provide transport to/from the destination airport. The Tom Quilty Committee is to provide accommodation from Thursday to Sunday night inclusive and meals while the ride is in progress. The Tom Quilty Committee is to also provide one dinner ticket. The Chief Steward is responsible for incidental travel costs and meals outside the ride.**

**Voting** Carried Unanimously

**Moved** Tom McCormack/Pat Hodgetts

**That AERA write a formal letter to each Division inviting them to nominate a second Chief Steward who is not part of the core team to attend the Quilty under the same conditions as the core team but with the State Division picking up the airfare/fuel costs.**

**Voting** Carried Unanimously. Anne to write to the States

**Catastrophes:** There has been 4 catastrophes in Queensland, one in FNQ, one at the FEI State Championships and 2 at Jericho. An independent review panel has been set up to investigate the catastrophe in FNQ. All the relevant tests were done following the Imbil incident. The PM results found a pre-existing underlying infection that was difficult to operate on and the prognosis was poor. The summary was read. It was found that riding alone was not the factor that caused the horse's death.

The Jericho incidents are still being investigated

#### **Accredited Chief Stewards**

**Moved** Ross McCamish/Dorte Colja

**That Liz Cullam (WA), Lainie Ray and Melanie Scott (SA) are accepted as AERA Accredited Chief Stewards.**

**Voting** Carried Unanimously.

### **Post-ride Surveys**

One possibility would be to change the way the computer does it. Only factor the heart rate in once rather than three times. The heart rate could be factored in using a CRI.

Carol would like the vet panel to have a look at this aspect and find another way around this.

It was agreed that Kerry would write letter to refer the fittest horse award concept to the vet panel for consideration where it relates to heart rate. Could they look at the merits of the heart rate calculation as it is now done? Could it be modified to reflect less emphasis on the heart rate?

Carol Layton said she was looking to find the DVD's for promotion. Annette said she gave them to Martin.

AGM dates and venue. Possible dates for the AGM were considered with reference to the ride calendar.

# Ride Bases Map

The NSWERA Web page now has a Google map with 'Find it' features that will show the distribution of ride bases through NSW and provide a map with directions from your home to the ride base.

To access the map just go to **www.nswera.asn.au**. When you get there just click on the "NSW Ride Base Map" towards the top of the screen.

## **To use the map: -**

- Click on the ride base in the list on the left.
- A text box will pop up near the flag for the ride base.
- Click on get directions 'to here'.
- Enter your hometown in the start address.

## **Click 'GO' and print off the map and directions.**

**If you have a navigator in your vehicle** the map coordinates are shown in the text box, but a word of caution when using a navigator to go to a map grid reference, navigators are programmed to find the most direct route (as the crow flies), and as you get close to your destination they sometimes want to turn you down a side road or even a forest trail.

## **Ride organisers**

### **To have a ride base added to the map,**

1. Go to Google on the internet.
2. Select 'Maps' from the menu bar at the top.
3. With a map of Australia showing.
4. the curser (a little hand) on the area you're interested in, right click and select 'Center map here'.
5. Slide the up the scale ladder a little.
6. Repeat 4&5 until you have zoomed in on the area.
7. Now select 'Satellite' to see an overhead picture of the area.
8. Put the 'Little Hand' on the gateway to the ride base, right click and select 'Directions from Here'.
9. A green flag will appear at the spot and a 'Get directions' box will appear in the top left corner.
10. If the flag is not quite right, click and drag it.
11. In the 'Get directions' box against flag 'A' will be the map grid reference for the spot chosen, it will look like ( -30.294007,147.498579)
12. Jot down that reference with the ride name and email it to me at 'vpe63190@bigpond.net.au'.

**To check we have located the marker correctly, or if the ride base has been moved, zoom in on your marker on the Ride Bases Map as described above, switch to Satellite and check the position of the marker. If it is in error follow the procedure above and email me the details.**

Also run some tests approaching your ride base from different directions and note any anomalies, see the Shahzada text box for an example.

**Following a recommendation from the AERA International Committee (AERA IC), the AERA has agreed that a \$5.00 affiliation fee should be paid to the AERA IC for each horse entered into a FEI ride. Ride Organisers should add this amount to their ride entry fee.**

## Transfer of Ownership Procedures

It is the responsibility of the purchaser of the horse to notify the State of the change in ownership details. It is important that the correct person be registered as the owner of the horse as this assists with the correct allocation of National and State distance and pointscore awards as well as identifying the persons responsible for the horse when disciplinary actions need to be instituted.

### Process for Changing Ownership Details

When a sale of a horse occurs and the horse has had a logbook issued it is the responsibility of the new owner to notify the State of the change of ownership. A transfer of ownership form must be completed and forwarded to the State, together with a cheque for \$11 and the logbook.

Once the transfer of ownership form is received the logbook can be amended with the change in owners and the transfer verified by the Logbook Secretary/Registrar.

#### Procedure for Recording Change of Ownership

Transfer of ownership forms are to be made readily available to all members, preferably through the State Newsletters or upon application to the Logbook Secretary/Registrar.

Once a logbook, transfer of ownership form and fee are received the Logbook Secretary/Registrar will:

1. Record the ownership transfer into the logbook.
2. Verify the transfer.
3. Return the logbook.
4. Record the ownership transfer into the computer records of the State Division.
5. Keep a copy of the ownership transfer form and forward the original to the AERA Registrar.
6. Forward the \$5 fee to AERA.

## RIDE SECRETARIES

If you intend to change your ride details these changes **MUST** come in the form of a new application for approval by NSW ERA through the proper channels. No ride change requests are to be made direct to the newsletter.

# NSW ERA Ride Booking Procedures

1. A ride must be booked a minimum of three months prior to the proposed date for the ride. This requirement may only be waived with the consent of the State Management Committee (**SMC**) under exceptional circumstances.
2. Ride Committees must be incorporated with the Department of Fair Trading and a copy of the Certificate of Incorporation forwarded with Booking Form.
3. Entry fees for all sections of the ride must be shown on the Booking Form and advertised in the Newsletter when inserted in the Ride Calendar.
4. Rides being conducted to replace cancelled rides must have permission from the NSW ERA SMC before the ride is advertised ANYWHERE.
5. Existing rides that have run on the same date for consecutive years will have preference for that date over new rides to protect the survival of the existing rides.
6. If a new ride is allocated a date other than as requested, that Ride Committee must change their date in accordance with the Committees decision.
7. A \$10.00 Booking Fee is payable when lodging the Ride Booking Form.
8. A \$50.00 Bond is payable if this is not already held on behalf of the ride Committee. This bond may be used for the next ride by that Committee if all paperwork is in on time.
9. The Ride Booking Form will indicate the Ride Committee's request for their ride to be dual-affiliated with another State.
10. A letter will be forwarded to Ride Committees one month prior to their ride requesting confirmation of the ride's Head Vet and Accredited Chief Steward.

## Logbook & Identification Procedures

A horse is a novice for a minimum of 90 days from the date on which it successfully completes its first affiliated endurance ride and may only attempt four rides during this period, ie if a horse successfully completes its first ride on 1st July, it cannot upgrade to endurance status until after 28th September and may only enter four rides during this period. There is no limit on the time it takes to reach endurance status. Your horse can be a novice for as many months (or years) as you like.

When your horse has successfully completed 240 kms of affiliated endurance (not training) rides, it can be upgraded from novice (blue log book) to endurance (yellow log book) status.

Ensure the brands are clear. If not, have the horse re-branded or microchipped (Refer to rule H5.2(a) - (b) ) and H5.3).

Have a vet complete the horse identification form (written description and diagrams) and sign it. Identification and microchipping can be done at most rides, but it is advisable to check with the ride secretary beforehand.

Complete the logbook application form and attach I.D. form, novice horse logbook and the appropriate fee.

Please allow 10 working days from date of posting for return.

It is essential to retain a copy of the I.D. form and perhaps have it laminated for the future.

PLEASE NOTE An Endurance Horse Logbook will not be issued unless a signed Veterinary Identification Form **is** enclosed with the application. The I.D. in the novice log book is NOT acceptable.

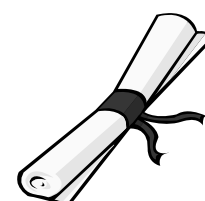
